## Here's What we are Learning!

### READING

Your child should be able to read short vowel words (cvc words), words with consonant digraphs and blends. We will continue to focus on words with long vowels (cvce and vowel digraphs) and multisyllabic words. Our stories this month focus around friends, plants, and insects. Continue to practice reading at home with your child. They should be able to read short vowel words and all their sight words in their books.

#### MATH

We will be finishing up Unit 6 and start Unit 7! We will learn about attributes of shapes, compose and decompose composite shapes, and divide shapes into halves and fourths. We will also continue to tell time and use place value to add and subtract larger numbers!

Continue to practice addition and subtraction facts at home.
