You Are Not Alone: How To Help Children & Adults Experiencing Grief, Loss & Trauma

Workshop Description: As educators and in our personal lives, we encounter students, friends, family, and peers who have experienced loss or trauma and are dealing with grief. We will explore types of loss, differences in how children and adults react to loss and trauma, and how to support those who are grieving. The morning session will cover types of loss in childhood, how children react to trauma and loss and the effect it has on the developing brain, and how children grieve differently than adults. We will discuss how to support them in the school setting and elsewhere. The afternoon will cover types of loss experienced by adults, how adults grieve, grieving styles, expectations in American society about grief, and how to support adults who have suffered loss or trauma.



Presenter Information: Terri Gray
Terri is a Grief & Loss Counselor and Coach, certified by the American Association of Christian Counselors. She earned both her B.A. and M.A. in Communication Disorders & Sciences at Wichita State University, and worked as a speech-language pathologist, serving ages birth through adult, in both private and public schools for 37 years. Working with students with special needs and their families, and experiencing the recent death of loved ones led her to explore the various types of loss and the grieving process. This ultimately led her to become a Certified Grief & Loss Coach and Counselor and hospice bereavement volunteer. She is currently working with her church, Heartland Hospice, and the Wichita Catholic Diocese, presenting workshops and offering counseling and support in the areas of grief and loss.
