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## Here's What we are Learning!

## Reading

We have worked really hard on reading and decoding short vowel words! Your child should be able to read and attempt to sound out short vowel words (cvc words). We will now focus on reading words with consonant blends. Our stories this month focus around the holiday season. Continue to practice reading at home with your child. They should be able to read short vowel words and all their sight words in their books.

#### Math

We are starting Unit 4! We will be focusing on two concepts: length measurement and addition fact fluency. We will also transition from displaying data in tally charts to displaying data in bar graphs. We will also begin developing strategies for adding more than two numbers and using place value to mentally add or subtract 10.
