THINGS TO PRACTICE AT HOME

- Subtraction Facts through 20: All students should have subtraction fact cards in their STAR Binders. Have them practice these very important facts nightly by counting backwards on a number line, counting up, knowing patterns in the facts, relating them to addition, etc. Knowing these facts automatically and fluently and being able to explain how they know the difference will help them so much in 3rd grade and beyond.
