

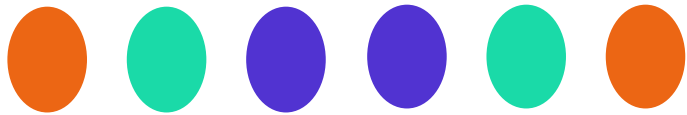

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Having students with chronic conditions in the classroom can be intimidating and cause stress for teachers and other school staff. The needs of children with chronic illness can be complex and continuous and includes both daily management and addressing potential emergencies. This workshop covers ways to help staff understand the special needs of students suffering from a chronic illness, how to recognize health events that may interfere with learning, and suggestions for appropriate interventions.



In addition to other illnesses, conditions such as diabetes, epilepsy, ADHD, asthma, and allergies will be discussed.

PRESENTER: Lesley Thomas, MEd, RN, NCSN

Lesley Thomas, MEd, RN, NCSN is the Assistant District Nurse for Haysville Public Schools. Lesley holds a Master's of Science in Health Education, a Bachelor's of Science in Health Promotion, an Associate's Degree in Nursing, and is a Nationally Certified School Nurse. She is also a CPR instructor and teaches classes for the district. She has worked at the American Diabetes Association (ADA), the Sedgwick County Health Department, and Wichita Public Schools.
