## THINGS TO PRACTICE AT HOME

Try having the students record themselves reading using an app on your phone and then having them listen back and discuss together what went well and what they could improve on.
- Multi-digit Addition with and without regrouping. We are beginning 2-Digit Subtraction with borrowing. This is often a tricky Math skill to master!
