- ◆ Discuss the critical piece of parents and community

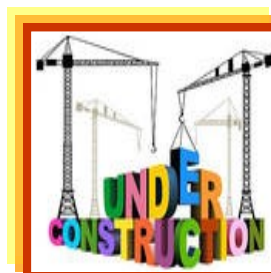
PRESENTER: TANYA VEST
