## STUDENT NEWS? BROADCAST IT!

### WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Share and celebrate student news through online school or classroom broadcasts! Enhance technology integration through the use of film projects incorporated in any subject area! During this workshop, participants will explore student news broadcasts and other ways to incorporate filming and editing in the classroom. The first half of the day we will review how to use digital news broadcasts to create community by celebrating accomplishments and sharing current events and classroom projects. We will explore elements of a broadcast and learn how to create and use a PowerPoint script. In the afternoon,



we will expand our knowledge by using video cameras, green screen, and PowerDirector software to create sample news videos posted to YouTube. Participants will leave ready to implement or expand video broadcasting in their school or classroom.

### PRESENTER: Esther Eash & Amber Marshall

Esther Eash has thirty years of experience teaching students K-12 and providing teacher training. She is currently in her fourth year as library teacher at USD261-Oatville Elementary. She holds a BA in Art/Art Education from Bluffton (Ohio) University and a Masters in Library Science from Indiana University. She enjoys finding new ways to engage students in authentic learning opportunities.

Amber Marshall has six years of experience teaching students K-8. She is currently in her second year as technology teacher at USD261-Oatville Elementary. She holds a BA in Elementary Education from Wichita State University and a Masters in Educational Technology. She enjoys integrating student-centered technology projects in her classroom in order to maximize student learning.

Esther and Amber are co-directors of Oatville's News Network (ONN), a daily news program led by student newscasters. During the 2016-2017 school year, they switched the broadcast from analog to a digital online format, expanded the variety of news elements, incorporated green screen techniques, and provided participation opportunities for more students.
