Please check agendas and backpacks for important notes from the teacher and school.

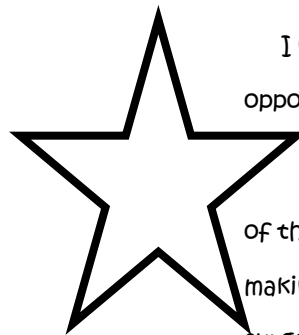
Ways to keep students focused until Winter Break: have a normal bedtime, eat a healthy breakfast and keep a regular homework time.
