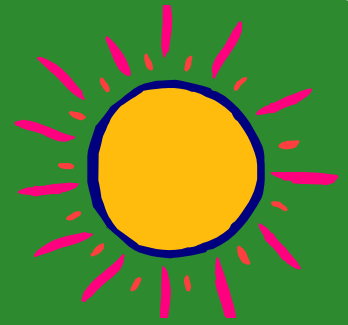

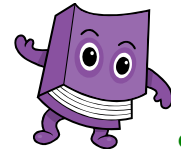

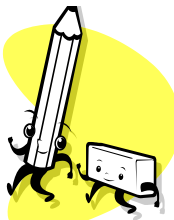
HOMWORK!!
