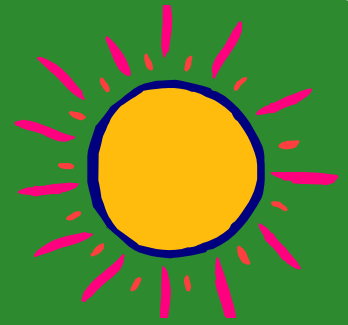

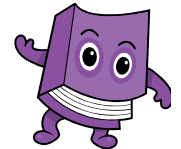

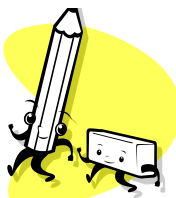
## HOMWORK!!
